

## Motocross Camp Required Gear & Supply Information Form

Motocross is a fun and dynamic sport, however there is a degree of danger, and as a result there is always a risk to bodily injury. The Ranch at Jesus Canyon employs a full time Safety Officer, an onsite EMT, an onsite FCC Certified Helipad for emergency evacuations to the Regional Medical Center in Victorville, and takes every safety precaution, but riders must understand they ride at their own risk. Additionally we do require certain minimum safety gear, and ask that all riders abide by our Ranch Rules. We will do everything within our power to make the riding experience both fun, challenging, safe and memorable for all camp participants and track riders.

**In addition to a working and well maintained bike\* the following safety equipment and supplies are required for your attendance in the Motocross Camp at The Ranch:**

### **Required Safety Equipment**

- Full-Face MX Helmet
- MX Goggles
- Gloves
- Long Pants
- Knee/Shin Pads
- Elbow Pads
- MX Chest Protector
- Long Sleeve Shirt
- Boots (that cover the ankles)

### Supplies

Gas Can  
Money for Gas  
Money for Mechanical Repairs (suggested \$100.00 for the week)  
Front Break lever  
Clutch lever  
Intertube for front and rear tire  
Oil

**NOTE: Although The Ranch at Jesus Canyon is committed to the safety of all riders, accidents can and do occasionally happen. All Motocross Camp participants are required to sign a Liability Release Waiver before riding. Parents/Guardians must sign for minors, no participants will be allowed to enter the property without a signed and completed release as a part of their registration paperwork. Further, all participants must have valid health insurance and be able to show proof of health insurance as a part of their registration papers.**

\*Bikes may be rented for those traveling from out of the area
